OVERVIEW

YourPassion1st is a unique international non-profit organization 501(c)3 that empowers under-resourced young adults to find, define, and follow their passion into the workforce or entrepreneurship, becoming the world's future innovators. We look to transform communities by inspiring young adults to leverage their passion through mentorships, collaborative events & festivals, innovative workshops, coaching and mentoring programs, and project-based learning experiences.

Numerous young adults around the world are suffering from depression and a number of other mental health challenges, as they strive to be productive members of society. We are actively working on strategies to help young adults turn their passions into careers in Art, Music, Entertainment, Sports/Wellness, Culinary/Nutrition and more. Our goal is to make neighborhoods safer, while minimizing mental health challenges in young adults by providing them the tools and resources necessary to tap into their passion while distilling it into sustainable income.

I'm So Grateful

Upwards of 50,000 opportunity youth in Chicago are disconnected from the mainstream — not attending school and ill-prepared for the workforce or higher education. From our research and experiences, young adults across the globe are experiencing similar challenges. According to the McKinsey Global Institute, future predictions of African-American unemployment in 2030 suggest further widening the wage gap between races, ages, and socioeconomic classes. To make matters even worse, the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic has exploded the suicide rate to 9.5x the average from ages 10-24 (Brown University), has destroyed small businesses and the economic heartbeat of communities, and negatively compounded the tourism industry. High unemployment rates lead to depression, low self-esteem, lack of financial resources, violence, opportunities to engage in less productive activities, and blocked perceptions of routes for building thriving families, communities, and productive working careers.

These significant problems plague young African American adults in Illinois and devastate under-resourced communities worldwide. YourPassion1st has been building a platform that allows young adults to vulnerably find, define, and follow their passions into the workforce or as entrepreneurs.

Young adults need safe spaces, a multitude of resources, and confidence which can help improve self-worth. Over the past three years, we've found that passion inspires confidence, which can transform young adults into productive young role models that uplift their community.

We are thankful for the opportunity to serve our community, and looking forward to another amazing year!

2022 Programs

- In partnership with Mi Casa Holiday & Insight In You, from May Dec 2022, we were able to **mentor and coach 35 young adults 5 from South Africa, 20 from Chicago, and 10 from Brazil,** by connecting them with skill-based mentors & mental health coaches as they find, define, & follow their passion into the workforce. Thanks to BUILD Chicago & West Side Health Authority for your partnership through the One Summer Chicago Program.
- Our young adults were able to collaborate with other young adults from around the world, in similar areas of passion and **showcase 5 team projects**, which helped them hone in on their areas of passion and get one step closer to earning revenue (creating value), as they find, define, and follow their passion into the workforce or entrepreneurship.
- We co-hosted our **Wellness Festival** in partnership with A Greater Good Foundation, our Youth Empowerment Festival in partnership with Chicago Westide Chamber of Commerce, Austoberfest in partnership with Project Exploration, and our Team Project Showcase hosted at Gone Again Travels.
- Thanks to Paint the City, Star Events & Chicago Loop Alliance, we were able to have a number of our **young adults sell their products at Sundays on State**, **and connect with a number of resources & organizations** to support them as they find, define, and follow their passion into the workforce.]
- Thanks to the amazing partnership with Pastor Mac & What About Us
 Charitable Enterprises Inc. we were able to support a number of summer pop-up events at LaFollette Park, providing fun, entertainment, and engagement to the community.
- Also in partnership with What About Us Charitable Enterprises Inc and Mt. Olivet M.B. Church we were able to provide food, groceries, and resources to 1,500+ families here on the West Side of Chicago.
- In partnership with GreenStar Movement & AAABNA, we were able to create an amazing mosaic on the front of AAABNA.
